- Lifeflight Ambulance will now be serving the Lincoln County hospitals.
- At the Siletz City Council meeting there was a discussion about Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU's) which was approved. Also, met with Arron Growth from OSU Extension on data from wildland fires and answered questions about the Siletz Fire program.
- Met with the youth group who will be working to clean up property and create defensible space. Potential partnership.
- Met with PUB w/ tree removal assistance.
- As rainy weather has started there are a lot of questions about the burn permits opening back up but there may be warmer temperatures ahead so this on hold.
- Fire today in Toledo, was a total loss. We assisted along with other agencies.
- Gerry asked a question regarding the USDA loan and making sure that we are communicating the
 grant funds and how the new rescue unit would be paid for. Also, a discussion about the board
 writing articles for the newsletters.
